**Participants should select one topic from TV, Mobile Phone, Cinema, Home Works, Examinations, English Medium, Nuclear Energy, Death Sentence, Chemical Fertilizers, Punishments in Schools. Participants will have to write a preliminary examination either 'for' or 'against'. Selected Groups will further participate in Oral Debate on the same topic.

Each student can Participate either in Quiz or in Debate but not in both as they are conducted at the same time. All the competitions are individual if not mentioned as a 'Group'. Participants can participate either in Telugu or English.
